Summary of Tournament Rules:

- 1) Contest will be held Friday, June 15th, 2012. Registration from 7:00am to 8:00am. All boats must be checked back in by 2:30pm – no exceptions. In case of bad weather conditions, the reschedule date will be Saturday, June 16th, 2012; same registration and check in times. Official weigh in will be at Sebewaing Harbor Marina immediately following check-in.
- 2) Maximum of 6 persons per boat. All entrants must hold a valid Michigan Fishing License or be exempt (under 17 years) from holding a license and abide by the rules and creel limits set forth by the Department of Natural Resources. Entrants must abide by all State Boating Laws and Department of Natural Resources Rules and Regulations.
- 3) Each entrant agrees to hold any of the contest sponsors harmless from any liability of any nature and kind, for any injuries and/or disagreements suffered by the entrant before, during, or after the contest.
- 4) Only one fish per boat will be weighed for the heaviest non-walleye. For the heaviest 5 walleye, the total weight will be used to determine the winner. In the event of a tie, length will be used. For the heaviest non-walleye, length will be used to determine the winner if a tie occurs.
- 5) All decisions are final. All prizes will be team prizes.

Summary of Tournament Rules:

1. Contest will be held Friday, June 15th, 2012. Registration from 7:00am. to 8:00am. All boats must be checked back in by 2:30pm – no exceptions. In case of bad weather conditions, the reschedule date will be Saturday, June 16th, 2012; same registration and check in times. Official weigh in will be at Sebewaing Harbor Marina immediately following check-in.
2. All entrants must register at the official checkpoint at Sebewaing Harbor Marina by 8:00am. Sebewaing Harbor Marina reserves the right to limit the number of participating boats.
3. Maximum of 6 persons per boat. All entrants must hold a valid Michigan Fishing License or be exempt (under 17 years) from holding a license and abide by the rules and creel limits set forth by the Department of Natural Resources. Entrants must abide by all State Boating Laws and Department of Natural Resources Rules and Regulations.
4. Boats used by entrants must meet all Federal and State boat safety requirements, and be able to carry the specified amount of people and gear.
5. All fish entered must be caught by hook and line on the day of the contest within the designated fishing areas: all of the Saginaw Bay. Entrants will be subject to disqualification should it be determined that the presented fish were not caught during the specified time period. The entrant acknowledges receipt of a copy of the rules and regulations, and agrees to abide by all stated and implied conditions. Entrants will be disqualified for violation of any tournament rules.
6. Each entrant agrees to hold any of the contest sponsors harmless from any liability of any nature and kind, for any injuries and/or disagreements suffered by the entrant before, during, or after the contest. Entrants are also expected to follow the highest standards of courtesy, safety, and angling etiquette.
7. For your safety, even if you have no fish to weigh in, please check in at the weigh in area so we know all boats have returned safely to shore.
8. Each boat may enter a maximum of 5 walleye and 1 non-walleye at the weigh in. Only one fish per boat will be weighed for heaviest non-walleye. For the heaviest 5 fish, the total weight will be used to determine the winner. In the event of a tie, length will be used.
9. All decisions are final. All prizes will be team prizes.
